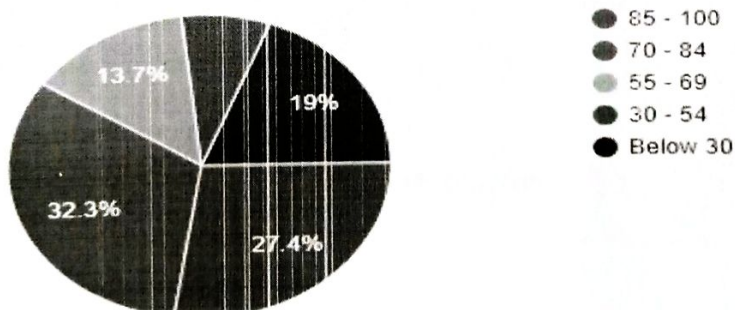
Introduction:

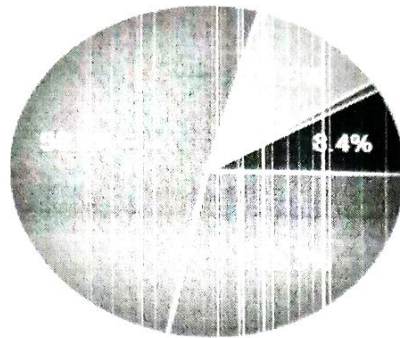

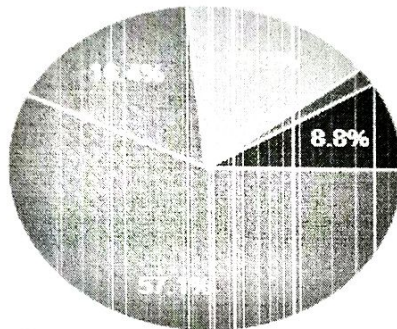


2. How well did the teachers prepare for the class?



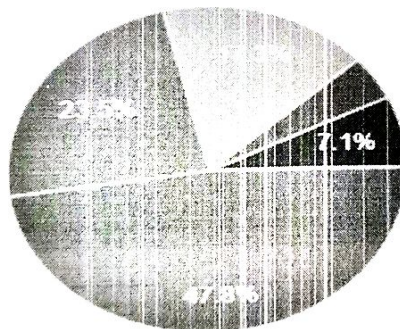

3. How well were the teachers able to communicate?



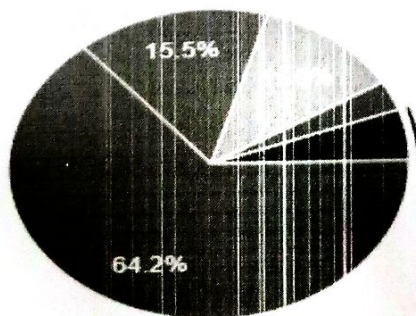

4. The teacher's approach to teaching can be best be described as.



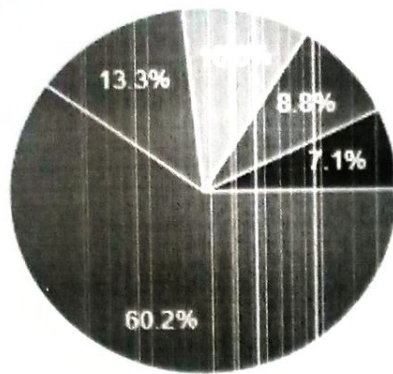

5. Fairness of the internal evaluation process by teacher



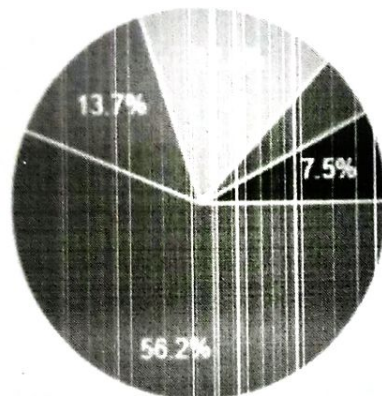

6. Was your performance in assignments discussed with you



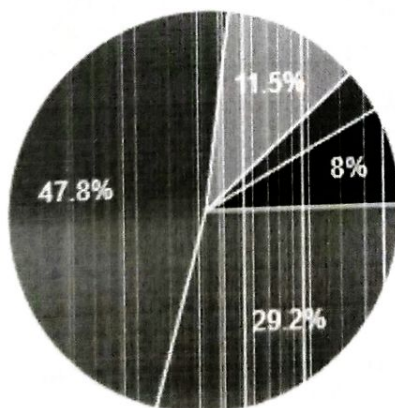

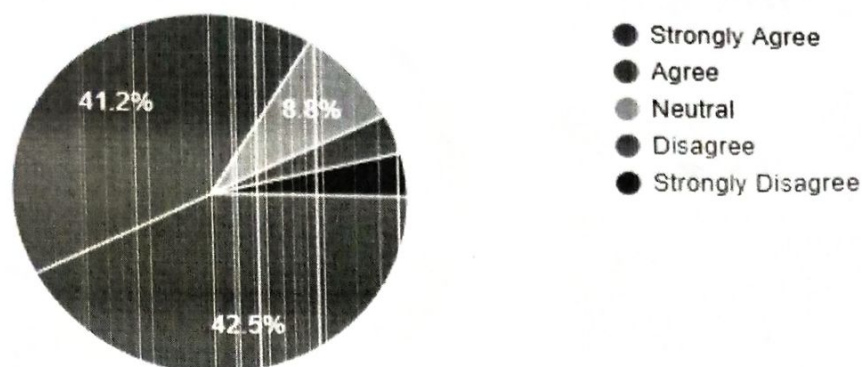

8. The Teachers and monitoring process in your institution facilitates you in cognitive, social and emotional growth

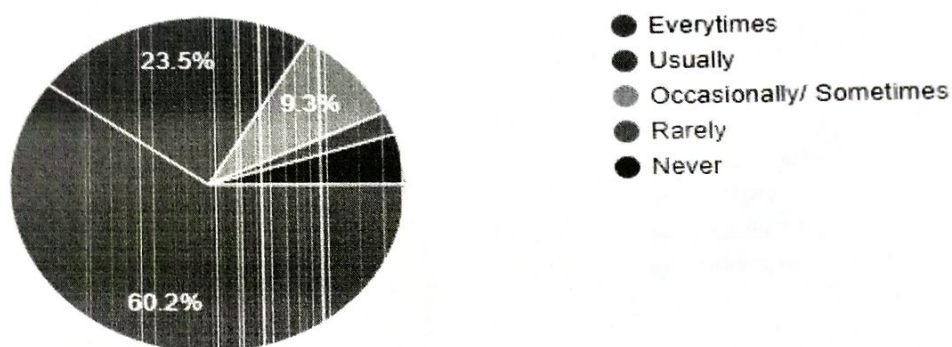

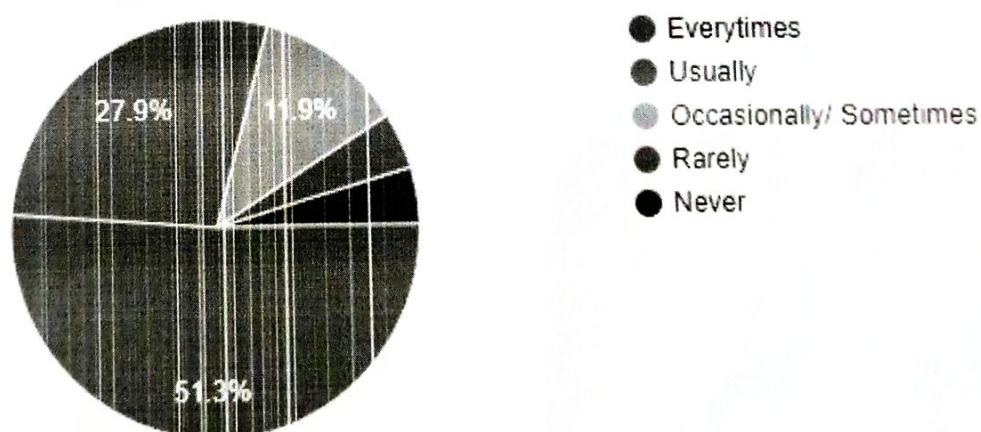

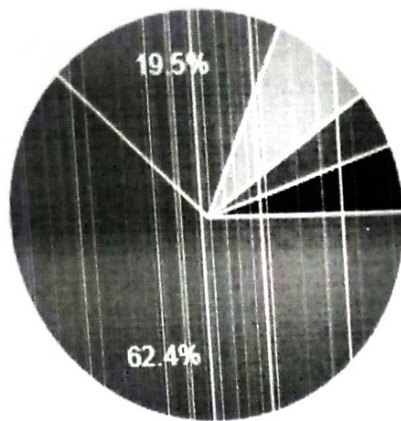

11. Your mentor does a necessary follow-up with an assigned task to you

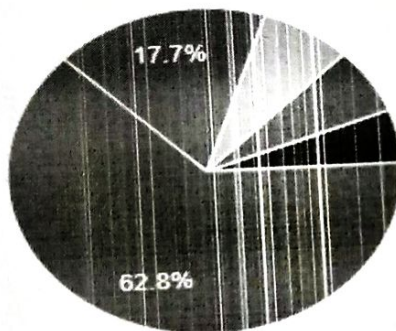

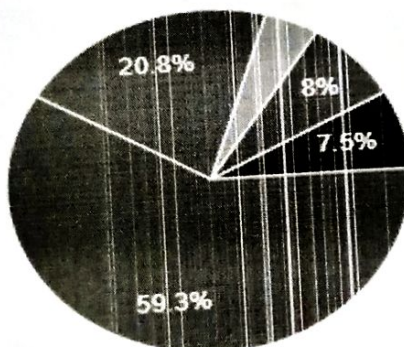

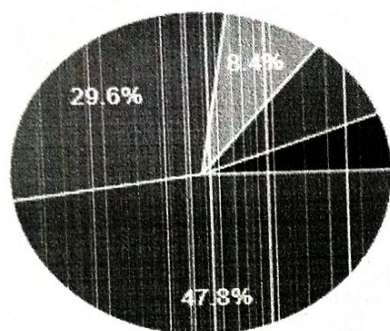

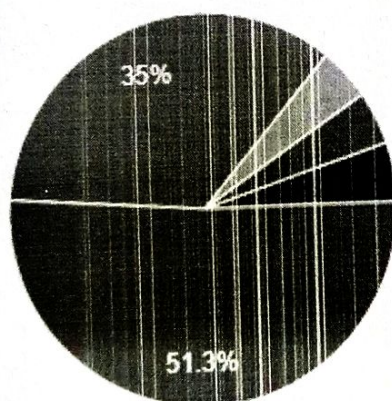

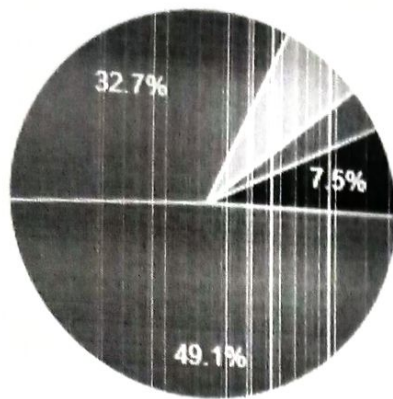

17. The Teachers encourage you to participate in extracurricular activities



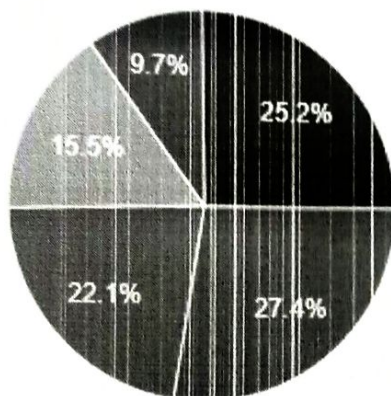

18. Efforts are made by the institute/ teachers to inculcate soft skills, life skills and employability skills to make you ready for the world of work.



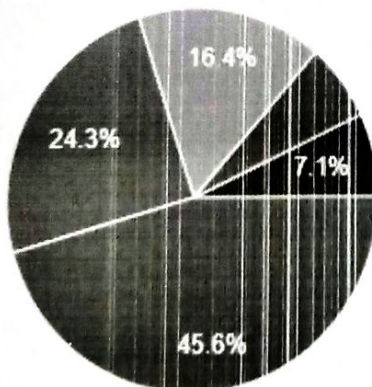


