

## **Students Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report 2020-2021**

The Students' Feedback on curriculum and teaching learning process of Government Degree College Poonch is designed to get formative feedback from students that can be used towards the improvements in the quality of course design and delivery, as well as student learning experiences. For the Academic Session 2020-2021, students' feedback received through Google Form Online Mode from 304 students of GDC Poonch on curriculum and other related aspects of teaching learning process. This feedback also focused on other important issues like delivery of curriculum by teachers. Majority of the students (25%) Strongly Agreed and 61% Agreed that the syllabus is very much challenging and the allocation of credits is appropriate in relation to the level of course work. 95% of the students strongly agreed that the syllabus is covered by the teachers well in time. Around 85% of the students Agreed that the content provided in the syllabus is well sequenced and equipped them with necessary technical skills required for their professional areas. It is observed that 23% of the respondents Strongly Agreed and 60% Agreed that the courses are in tune with their respective field of specialization. The students' feedback revealed that 22% of them Strongly Agreed and 58% agreed that the evaluation process is fair and unbiased in the college. Also, majority of students (88%) Strongly Agreed and Agreed that the teachers are punctual and well prepared for taking the classes. Majority of the students 27% Strongly Agreed and 57 % Agreed that sufficient reference books and reading materials are available for the students in the college library. 83% students Strongly Agreed and Agreed that the students grievances/problems are redressed and solved well in time. 82% students Strongly Agreed and Agreed that the college campus is spacious and accessible to differently abled students. 88% students

Agreed that the objectives of the syllabus are well defined and applicable in daily life.

The analysis of the students' feedback clearly depicted that they were well satisfied with the curriculum development of the college. The students highly appreciated the academic related infrastructural facilities such as library, laboratories, playground and other facilities. The college decided to renovate college canteen and purchase more syllabus and reference books to meet out the genuine demands of the students. It is observed from the students' feedback that few of them expressed the need of library automation and subsequently college decided to automate the library of the college as soon as possible. An inclusive report has been prepared and communicated to the concerned authority for the redressal of shortcomings (if any) and overall improvement of curriculum related issues in the college.
